

NHS Flu Season 2017/18

Here's the performance figures for the year to date to the end of January. Please note these only include pharmacies that used PharmOutcomes to record, so the final figure will be somewhat higher.

Performance for September & October 2018

September volume was much lower 9,342 v 22,752 vaccinations (-58%), a reversal of last year's trend (+101%)
October volume was just higher 22,845 v 20,494 vaccinations (+11%), which built on last year's trend (+45%)

Performance for November & December 2018

Combined volume was much higher 16,051 v 7,178 vaccinations (+124%), in comparison to last year's trend (+15%)

Year to date performance to January 2019

Provisional total is 49,459 v 50,424 (-1.9%), in comparison to last year's trend of +60%

Other highlights:

Isle of Wight are +5.3% up on last year (*Southampton +2%, Hampshire +1.7%, but Portsmouth was -25.7%*)

Portsmouth had a reversal of last year's big increase on number of vaccines per pharmacy, achieving 136.5 v 179.4 LY, (*Isle of Wight 213.7 v 196.4, Hampshire 138.5 v 132.8 & Southampton 110.4 v 103.3 vaccinations per pharmacy*).

Our local performance (-1.9%) is a little behind the figures being achieved nationally (estimated at + 5.9%), although strangely the drop in Portsmouth is skewing the figures dramatically from an increase of around 2.5%
