

## University Hospital Southampton (UHS) DMS Update

With the change to DMS, PharmOutcomes no longer allows UHS to add any free-text in the usual place. Information about any changes to medicines is now being put in a note which is pulled through onto the PharmOutcomes template. This note appears in a box called Notes and Actions right at the bottom of the referral under Recommendations.

Unfortunately this comes after a box which claims that no medicines or medical devices have been reported as being stopped which can lead to some confusion.

Please remember to read the Discharge referral right to the bottom to get the message from the pharmacist about any changes.
