




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
Crude abortion rate per 1,000 women, by age and IMD decile, England 2021



Teenage Conceptions: >50% leading to abortion





No lower or upper age cap

Consideration: on average approx. 50 CYP in Portsmouth at risk of CSE and 100 at risk of CCE (some CYP at risk of both)

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STIs and HIV: Portsmouth

- High prevalence of HIV
- Increased late diagnosis (>50%)
- Second highest rate of new STIs in South East

- Highest STI testing rate
- Free postal home-sampling kits available
 - Free condoms by post
