Flu vaccine ordering and planning for 21/22 flu season

Approved Vaccines

The following JCVI recommended vaccines will be reimbursed as part of the NHS Annual Influenza Vaccination Programme for adults in 2021/22.

Those aged 65 years and over	At-risk adults, including pregnant women, aged 18 to 64 years

Uptake expectations for the 21/22 flu vaccination service

Target vaccination percentages for each group will remain at 75%. AND

At present there are no plans to include the 50-64yr cohort within the national flu vaccination service for 21/22.

All providers should plan their flu vaccine ordering accordingly, taking into account the circumstances driving the flu vaccine uptake this year and excluding any volume of vaccine given to the 50-64yr group from Dec 1st onwards.

Manufacturers will start to produce volumes of vaccines shortly based on the orders they have received. Please submit your order as soon as possible.
